1. Mangayew kay man nan kailiyantakos na, omeydat 1. Our fellow villagers here went on a headhunting trip, betadenda nan iBelwang. they went and should out to the Ferwang¹ people. 2. Kangkang² was taken because he was left behind by 2. Maalas Kangkang tay nalasin si nan bintad, apednat those who accepted the challenge, he just threw his rice bekasen nan pagey tay insap-ey. inside, because he had been drying it in the sun. 3. Omalit makibaloknit, omali pay ya indawat Loyosen 3. He came to join the fighting, he came and Loyosen was waiting to get him and killed him, dead. et inpatevnat, inkakatev. 4. Maog-ogod pay et kanandan, "Siya sa tay igna adi 4. When the story was told, they said, "That happened bekinapen nan sinap-eyna ya omaliyay makibaloknit." cause he did not store away the rice he was drying before he came to fight." 5. Adi pay man inalan nan i-Ginaang nan olona tay 5. The Guinaang people did not get his head, because they tina-goda. (the Ferwang people) hid it (by taking the body). 6. Siya di nan inmat si nan naalan Kangkang. 6. That's what happened on the taking of Kangkang. 7. Nak-alda pay, sinmaalda ta in-gangsagangsada, 7. They cleared out, went home and played the gongs, had nanaw-esda, onas sin-es-a ay mangalak, kasin sin-es-ay the daw-es ceremony first with one hen and a dog each, aso, kasin ya kedeng ay tomtomwanda. then they performed the *tomo* ceremony. 8. Kasida pay ges maneldak, sin-es-a ay manok, ya sin-
