

Bontok Local Orthography Sort Order

Within the primary set, the first character in each line is ordered before the second, and the second character before the third, i.e., a word with an upper case character will precede an identical word with a lower case character. Similarly, a word with no accented vowels will precede an otherwise identical word that has an accented vowel. Secondary characters are ordered alphabetically after primary characters. The characters in the third column are ignored in the sorting order. The fourth column provides examples to illustrate the sort order.
