Bontok Phonemic Orthography Sort Order

Within the primary set, the first character in each line is ordered before the second, and the second character before the third, i.e., a word with no accented vowels will precede an otherwise identical word that has an accented vowel. The secondary character is ordered alphabetically after primary characters. The third column provides examples to illustrate the sort order. Note that words that begin with a glottal stop $\frac{1}{2}$ precede all other words. Also words that begin with a velar nasal $\frac{1}{2}$ follow words that begin with $\frac{1}{2}$.
