# Outline of Phonology of Lhaovo(Maru) of Kachin State

Sawada Hideo

## 1 Introduction

Lhaovo(Maru)<sup>1</sup> is the name of an ethnic group living in Kachin State and Northern part of Shan State in Union of Myanmar (formerly Burma), and *Déhóng* Dai-Jinghpaw Autonomous State in Yunnan Province, People's Republic of China.

The population of Lhaovos in China is 5000<sup>2</sup> and that in Myanmar is about 100,000.<sup>3</sup>

Lhaovo is considered to be a member of larger ethno-cultural group called "Kachin", together with neighbouring Jinghpaw, Lacid(Lashi), Zaiwa(Atsi) etc.

Linguistically, Lhaovo belongs to "Burmish" languages, together with Lacid, Zaiwa, Ngochang spoken in *Déhóng*, and all dialects of Burmese. Lhaovo is nearer to Burmese than Jinghpaw, the language of majority in "Kachin" ethno-cultural group.

In January and December 1997 and November 1998, I did research on Lhaovo language in Myitkyina, capital of Kachin State for about 20 days each time. Based on the research, I will present the outline of the phonology of Lhaovo spoken in Myitkyina.<sup>4</sup>

# 2 Syllable Structure

The syllable structure of Lhaovo is:

# 4 Medial Consonant

The only medial consonant of Lhaovo is /-y-/. It clusters with initial /m-, p-, ph-, k-, kh-/.

The reason why [au] is treated as the realization of single vowel phoneme /au/ is the cooccurence of it with final elements /-k/,/-ŋ/. Other phonetic diphtongs can never cooccur with any final elements, except in borrowed words.

## **6** Final Consonants

Final elements of a syllable are /-y, -ŋ, -k, -?, -n, -t, -p, -m/. It is not the case that all combinations of a vowel and a final element are possible.

## Rhymes with final -y

/ay/,/uy/,/auy/,/ey/ are realized as phonetically diphtongs. Yet we treat them as the combination of vowel + final element /-y/, contrary to /au/ as single phoneme, because there's no final element which follows /ay/,/uy/,/auy/,/ey/.<sup>7</sup>

#### Rhymes with final -k/-?

/-k/ cooccurs with vowel /a/,/au/,/u/; and /-?/ cooccurs with /a/,/e/,/ $\phi$ /,/o/. That is, /-k/ and /-?/ stand in opposition only after /a/.

The occurrence of /a?/ is almost restricted to particles, onomatopaes (e.g.  $\check{s}a$ ?F  $\check{s}a$ ?F "ONOMATOPAE", or words borrowed from Burmese, Jinghpaw, etc. The only exception in my data is cha?H "to hate".

## 7 The Feature [ $\pm$ Glottalized]

Lhaovo vowels show oppsition in respect with glottalizedness. For economy of description, The opposition is best treated as an independent feature [ $\pm$ Glottalized], rather than a part of vowel features.

The feature can cooccur with all vowels, final elements and tones.

The only element which shows cooccurrence restriction with this feature is Initial phoneme. Aspirated consonant /ph,th,tsh,ch,kh/ cannot cooccur with [+Glottalized]. /s, $\check{s},f,fi$ / and zero-initial only combine with [-Glottalized]. The initial consonant phonemes cooccuring with both [+Glottalized] and [-Glottalized] are  $/m,n,\tilde{n},\eta,p,t,t$   $ts,c,k,\chi^{16},l,r,y$ /.

I marked vowels of [+Glottalized] syllable with \_. It is merely for avoiding trouble-someness in transcribing and reading Lhaovo syllables.

## 8 Tonemes

Lhaovo has three tonemes:

- **Falling(F)** 21; Sometimes 32 in word-initial position followed by another F; 31 after L.
- **Low(L)** 22–33; Always 22 in word-initial position followed by F; the end of the syllable rises a little bit before another L.
- **High(H)** Syllables with final stop: 44; 42 in either it has a diphtong, or it is in word-initial position.

Syllables with final nasal, /-y/, or vowel: 44; 442 in word-final position; 34 in syllables with [+Glottalized] in word-initial position.

## 9 Phenomena concerning toneme

## 9.1 Syllable Weakening

All syllables in Lhaovo are not "full" syllable. Some syllable are "weak" ones, that is, syllables without inherent toneme. A weak syllable depends on the syllable immediately following it, therefore it cannot appear in word/phrase final position. In most cases, the pitch of weak syllable is lower than the onset pitch of the syllable immediately following it. But it is not always so. Weak syllables are indicated by "above vowels in this paper.

Some weak syllables are inherently weak, but some are "weakened" by syllable reduction.

An inherently weak syllable is either (i) a part of a word or (ii) a verbal prefix with grammatical function: e.g.  $\breve{a}$ - (deverbal nominal prefix),  $m\breve{a}$ - (prefix forming negative statement sentences),  $t\breve{a}$ - (prefix forming negative imperative sentences).

"Weakened" syllables are often found in noun compounding. Some monosyllabic nouns originally with inherent toneme are reduced to lose it, when they appear as a first element of compound noun consisting of two elements. But it is not the case that such a syllable reduction always happens in noun compounding.

Sometimes syllable reduction goes to an extreme: the vowel other than /a/ loses its original quality and becomes  $/\ddot{a}/$ .

#### 9.2 Tonal Alternation

Lhaovo shows the phenomena of tonal alternation in particular phonological or grammatical environment. <sup>18</sup> The pattern of alternation are as follows:

	BASIC	HEIGHTENED
Pattern 1	Falling	Low
Pattern 2	Low	High
Pattern 3	High	High

When BASIC form has High tone, the effect of tonal alternation is vacuous.

The elements showing tonal alternation are personal nouns, demonstrative nouns, numeral "ten" and verbs.

The reason why the leftmost terms of the above table are named BASIC and the rightmost terms are named "HEIGHTENED" are simply for the economy of description. If we treated the rightmost terms as basic, for each element showing tonal alternation (especially verb), we would specify the pattern of alternation in the lexicon. By treating the leftmost terms as basic, no such specification is necessary.

#### **Personal Noun**

When a personal noun is used as determiner of a noun, it takes "heightened" form.

When a demonstrative noun is used as determiner of a noun, it takes "heightened" form. Demonstrative noun indicating place, even if it is not used as determiner of a noun, takes "heightened" form.

#### Verb

A verb takes its "heightened" form mainly in two environments below:

- 1. Before particles beginning with /r-/
- 2. Before other verbs

The verbal particles beginning with /r-/ are -raH "SENTENCE CONSTRUCTOR: REALIS", -reF "if", -ruF "NOMINALIZER". In the following examples, verbs with Irrealis sentence constructor (taking basic form) and those with Realis sentence constructor (taking "heightened" form) are paired.

- X', X'' etc. (X is the number of entry) are synonyms of X.
- *Xa*, *Xb*, *Xc* etc. are supplementary words related to *X*.
- XN is the noun corresponding to the verb X, and
   XV is the verb corresponding to the noun X.
   Sometimes the original entry X is missing.
- In most verbs, both negative statement form with prefix  $m\breve{a}$  and affirmative statement form with -raH "REALIS" are recorded. The order is **NEGATIVE/AFFIRMATIVE**, because the form to which  $m\breve{a}$  is prefixed is "basic" form of verb, and the form to which -raH is attached is "heightened" form of verb.
- Abbreviations of word class are: [interj]=interjection, [n]=noun, [p]=particle, [prf]=prefix, [v]=verb. Phrasal expressions have no specification for category.
