

Detailed Regulations on Reproduction, Copying, and Lending
The Research Institute for Languages and Cultures of Asia and Africa (ILCAA)

Some of the materials stored and possessed in ILCAA Library are available for reproduction, copying, and lending when they are used for publication or academic uses, or when providers of the original materials and their descendants request to reproduce, copy, or lend them. Regarding “Naoyoshi Ogawa and Erin Asai Collection of Resources on Taiwan,” please also refer to the supplementary provisions.

1. Handle the original materials with care not to damage them
2. When returning the original materials, restore them to their original condition. When borrowing the original materials, take measures such as carrying insurance for their restitution.
3. In principle, the reproduction fee will be charged in accordance with the [Regulations](#) for Document Reproduction of the Tokyo University of Foreign Studies Library. However, the fee may be waived for providers of the original materials or for collaborators and their affiliates involved in arranging and preserving the resources.
4. The original and reproduced materials shall be used only for the purpose stated in your application, and shall not be used by or given to a third party.
5. Prior written permission is required for the reproduction, duplication, distribution, photography, audio or video recording, publication, performance, screening, public transmission or making available to the public (including uploading to a World Wide Web page), or broadcasting of the original material or reproduced materials provided to the user.
6. If you use the original materials or the reproduced materials for exhibition, performance, screening, public transmission or making available to the public (including posting on websites), broadcasting, or for publication based on such uses with permission, you shall make an appropriate reference to the Research Institute for Languages and Cultures of Asia and Africa, Tokyo University of Foreign Studies.
7. A copy of any publication based on the original materials or the reproduced materials provided to the user shall be donated to the Research Institute for Languages and Cultures of Asia and Africa.

Supplementary provisions

1. Concerning the “Naoyoshi Ogawa and Erin Asai Collection of Resources on Taiwan,” some of the materials are available for reproduction, copying, and lending when a formal request is submitted by the descendants and relatives of individuals who are subjects of collection, photography, filming, or recording of the materials or by official organizations inheriting the culture of the concerned ethnic groups, as well as when they are used for publication or academic uses and when providers of the original materials and their descendants request to reproduce, copy, or lend them. For your information, “official organizations inheriting the culture of the concerned ethnic groups” means organizations officially established by the national or local

government, like “The Council of Indigenous Peoples” of Taiwan.

2. In principle, regarding images (photographs), videos (films), and sound materials (records) from “Naoyoshi Ogawa and Erin Asai Collection of Resources on Taiwan”, lending the original/reproduced materials and providing the reproduced materials are only permitted to the descendants of the providers of the original materials, the descendants and relatives of individuals who are subjects of collection, photography, filming, or recording of the materials, or official organizations inheriting the culture of the concerned ethnic groups. However, some written materials (fieldnotes, vocabulary, etc.) are partially available for reproduction when they are used for publication or academic research.
